At Rainbow Children's Village, our Safe House provides a nurturing and stable home for children who have experienced abuse, neglect, or abandonment. Every child in our care deserves safety, dignity, and the chance to rebuild their sense of trust and security.

What is the Safe House?

The Rainbow Children's Village Safe House offers medium- to long-term residential care for vulnerable children who are placed with us by organisations registered with the Department of Social Development. We provide a structured, safe environment where children can begin to heal, supported by highly trained caregivers who prioritise their physical, emotional, and developmental wellbeing. We take in boys and girls aged 3 to 10 who have experienced sexual, emotional, or physical abuse, and children who require immediate safety, stability, and care.

What we provide

Children in our Safe House receive:

- A safe, stable home environment
- 24-hour care from trained caregivers
- Emotional support and routine
- Access to education and developmental support
- Daily meals, clothing, and essential care

Above all, we offer children something many have never known, a place where they feel safe and cared for.
